<p>Côtes-du-Rhône Réserve, Clos du Caillou 2019</p> <p>Châteauneuf-du-Pape in all but name, this is very full, spicy, formidably full-bodied and creamy in the 2019 vintage. Drink from 2023 to 2032. 14.5%</p>	RH59281	6	£109
<p>Crozes-Hermitage Les Marguerites, Domaine Cécillon 2019</p> <p>A gorgeous wine from a new up-and-coming estate, this is juicy, long and has wonderful ripe concentration of blueberry fruit. Drink from 2023 to 2030. 14%</p>	RH57901	6	£113
<p>Crozes-Hermitage, Domaine Sorrel 2019</p> <p>The French word which comes close to describing this wine is croquant – ‘crunchy’ doesn’t quite evoke the same sensation of biting into fresh fruit. Guillaume Sorrel, taking over from his father doesn’t separate the stalks from the fruit to preserve a feeling of freshness. In short - delicious! Drink from 2022 to 2027. 14%</p>	RH57981	6	£137
<p>Saint-Joseph Tilde, Domaine Pierre-Jean Villa 2019</p> <p>A wonderful expression of syrah: thick, black and chewy with layers of fruit and matter. Fabulous! Drink from 2023 to 2031. 14%</p>	RH58131	6	£160
<p>Cornas La Geynale, Domaine Vincent Paris 2019</p> <p>This young vigneron’s very old syrah vines on the Geynale slope have given a fleshy, concentrated Cornas with remarkable power in this vintage. Drink from 2025 to 2036. 14.5%</p>	RH58291	6	£209
<p>Saint-Joseph Rouge, Domaine Gonon 2019</p> <p>Yet again, this is in a class of its own: beautifully fragrant, rose-petal like, infinitely complex, refined and long. Drink from 2024 to 2032. 14%</p>	RH58151	6	£214
<p>Gigondas Clos des Tourelles, Perrin 2019</p> <p>Weighty, full-flavoured Gigondas from a plot in the heart of the village. Complex and rich with a mass of ripe, dark, figgy fruit. Outstanding in 2019. Drink from 2025 to 2041. 15%</p>	RH59221	6	£227

Gigondas Le Claux, Château de Saint Cosme 2019 RH59241 6 £324
Dense, dark and incredibly concentrated, thanks to its rare source material: a single plot of 110-year-old grenache vines. Outstanding! Drink from 2026 to 2040. 15%

Cornas Les Vieille Fontaines, Domaine Voge 2019 RH58331 6 £390
In a class of its own and made in small quantities, this terroir selection of old vines is thickly textured, savoury and rich. Drink from 2027 to 2040. 14.5%

Côte-Rôtie Fongeat, Pierre-Jean Villa 2019 RH58601 6 £397
A stunning, single-vineyard Côte-Rôtie, heavily laden with thickly textured, almost roasted fruit. Drink from 2026 to 2035. 13.5%

Hermitage Rouge, Domaine Marc Sorrel 2019 RH58671 6 £450
Deeply coloured, very fine with great length of flavour. Not quite as concentrated as the Gréal but more forward. Drink from 2024 to 2035. 14%

Côte-Rôtie Lancement, Domaine Garon 2019 RH58461 6 £485
Majestic, powerful, hugely impressive with lots of weight and concentration of matter. Drink from 2026 to 2039. 13.5%

Côte-Rôtie La Landonne, Domaine Rostaing 2019 RH58621 6 £490
A Côte-Rôtie that thinks it's a Hermitage! Monumental and multilayered in 2019. Drink from 2029 to 2040. 14%

Côte-Rôtie Côte Blonde, Domaine Rostaing 2019 RH58631 6 £525
Like Rostaing's Landonne, this is hugely concentrated and rich but is more backward and will need longer to come round. Drink from 2029 to 2045. 14%

Hermitage Les Bessards, Delas 2019 RH58701 6 £630
A tiny-production Hermitage of darkness, density and deliciousness, but it is built for long-term keeping. Drawn solely from the Bessards slope, this has huge depth of flavour and richness. Drink from 2026 to 2040. 14.5%

Hermitage Rouge Gréal, Domaine Sorrel 2019 RH58731 6 £750
Densely packed and very full bodied, this is a blend from two plots, Greffieux and Méal. Old vine concentration very evident in this great Hermitage. Drink from 2030 to 2045. 15%

<p>Crozes-Hermitage Blanc Maison Blanche, Vins de Vienne 2019</p> <p>Hermitage in all but name: the vineyard that is separated from the appellation border by just a track! Made from 60-year-old marsanne vines, this is full-flavoured and offers great purity of fruit and real grip. Drink from 2021 to 2029. 14%</p>	RH59711	6	£105
<p>Ventoux Blanc, Cuvée Juliette, Château Pesquié 2019</p> <p>A lovely micro-cuvée of mostly clairette with some grenache blanc. Ripe peach and pear with a touch of salinity on the finish. Finely balanced. Drink from 2021 to 2027. 13%</p>	RH59951	6	£122
<p>Saint-Péray Fleur du Crussol, Domaine Vogé 2019</p> <p>This marsanne is only made in good years, and in tiny quantities. It is fermented and then aged briefly in oak to round out the flavour, and the 2019 is particularly unctuous, weighty and fat. Drink from 2022 to 2031. 14.5%</p>	RH59831	6	£149
<p>Viognier, Esprit d'Antan, Domaine Pierre-Jean Villa 2019</p> <p>A very finely etched viognier grown on schist rather than granite. Fruity, balanced and long. Drink from 2021 to 2025. 13.5% Low stock.</p>	RH59501	6	£150
<p>Côtes-du-Rhône Blanc, Coudoulet de Beaucastel 2019</p> <p>A lovely rich-tasting and creamy Coudoulet this year, made from equal thirds of viognier (for apricot and peach flavour), marsanne (for structure) and bouboulenc (for food-friendly 'grip' on the palate). Drink from 2021 to 2026. 14%</p>	RH59881	12	£184
<p>Condrieu Jeanraude, Vins de Vienne 2019</p> <p>The Jeanraude vines are just above those of fabled vines of Château-Grillet. Very rich and splendid in 2019. Drink from 2021 to 2029. 14%</p>	RH59601	6	£195

Châteauneuf-du-Pape Roussanne Vieilles Vignes, Château de Beaucastel 2019	RH59921	3	£275
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100% roussanne, rich, decadent and a great food wine. It can be enjoyed young though the oak will be marked; its true greatness only reveals itself after many more years in bottle. Expect a very grand white wine of great depth and complexity. Drink from 2023 to 2036. 14%

Old vines of grenache, mourvèdre and syrah, fermented together to produce a thickly textured, spice-driven and weighty. Drink from 2024 to 2033. 15%

Vinsobres Rouanne et Crottes, Château de Rouanne

Similar blend of grapes and from the same slope but from sandier soils. Great depth and brightness of fruit. Drink from 2024 to 2033. 15%

Vinsobres Les Côtes, Château de Rouanne

Also from the slope but from limestone right at the top. Syrah and mourvèdre only. Lots of freshness and a deep tannic structure. Stunning! Drink from 2024 to 2035. 15%
